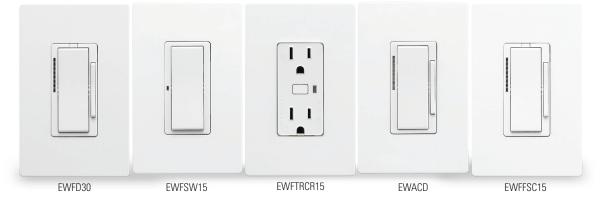

Your Wi-Fi Smart Switch

Control your lights from anywhere with Eaton's **Wi-Fi Smart Switch (EWFSW15)** which replaces standard switches and features ON/OFF control. The switch can be remotely controlled using the Brightlayer Home App.

Prior to installation

Requires neutral for installation WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS:

- Use only with 120V/AC 60Hz
- Do not exceed maximum rating of switch as indicated on the device
- Must be installed and used in accordance with all national and local electrical codes
- If a bare copper or green ground connection is not available in the wallbox, contact a licensed electrician for installation
- Use only #14 or #12 copper wire rated for at least 75°C with these devices

DO NOT USE WITH ALUMINUM WIRE

IMPORTANT: Wi-Fi Smart Switch (EWFSW15) will not work or will be damaged if wired incorrectly and warranty will be voided. Refer to wiring instructions provided.

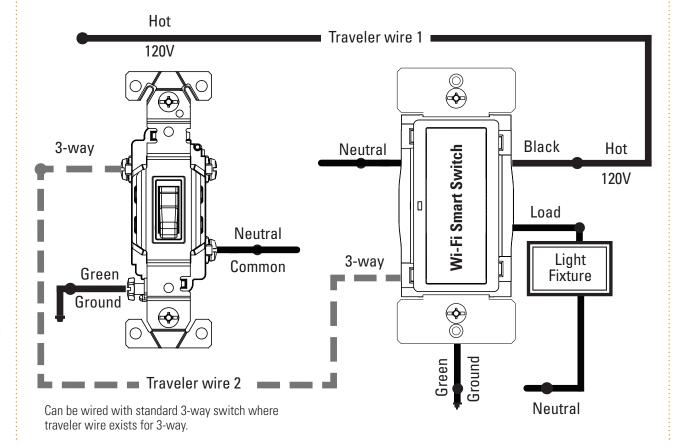
NOTE: The **Wi-Fi Smart Switch (EWFSW15)** is wired directly to the light fixture. For Multi-location applications (3-way) a regular 3-way switch can be used.



Single location installation (Black lines)



Two location control using a 3-way switch (gray lines)





Operation instructions

- Press ON button to turn lights ON
- Press OFF button to turn lights OFF
- When the lights are ON, press and hold the OFF button for 2 seconds until the LED indicator blinks. After a 10 second delay, the lights will turn off

FACTORY RESET: The switch can be reset which will exclude the device from its network and restore all factory defaults.

- Press and hold the ON button until the LED indicator blinks for the second time (30 secs)
- Release the button
- The LED indicator will start blinking again indicating the switch is not part of the Wi-Fi network



Safely leave room before lights turn off



Scan for more advanced features including adjusting the brightness level of the LED indicators and additional wiring configurations

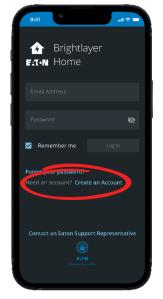

Set-up the Device

Add your device to the Brightlayer Home App

STEP 1: Double click on the "ON" button on the **Wi-Fi Smart Switch (EWFSW15)**. Status LED on the Wi-Fi Smart Switch should be blinking cyan to indicate that the device is in set-up mode. If the status LED is not blinking, refer to the Troubleshooting guide.

STEP 2 : Log in to your account on the Brightlayer Home App **STEP 3 :** Select "Devices" option



Once initial device is installed, additional devices can be added using the global add (+) button.

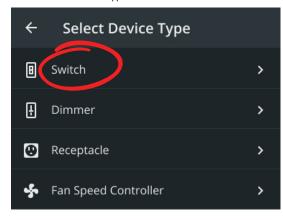


STEP 3 (continued):

Next click on "Add a Device" option shown in the screen below

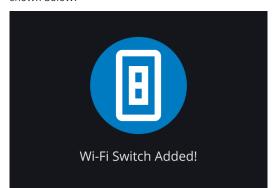


Select the device type to add

Troubleshooting guide

Erratic operation or flickering LEDs	Loose wiring connections	Check wiring and following instructions provided with the device	
Device functions normally using the switch push buttons but not from Brightlayer Home App. Purple LED indicator is blinking ON and OFF about once per second	Switch is not included in the Wi-Fi network	A) Include the switch in the Wi-Fi network using Brightlayer Home App B) Check that the router is functioning properly C) Go through the factory reset procedure and re-add the device to the Brightlayer Home App	
Device functions normally using the switch push buttons but not from Brightlayer Home App. Yellow LED indicator is blinking ON and OFF about once per second	No Wi-Fi signal	Check the router

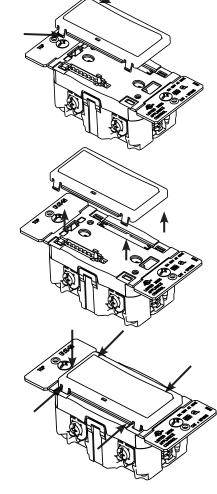
